## Band Member Expectations

- Each student will learn proper band etiquette for rehearsals and performances
- Each student will complete performance assignments involving rhythms, articulations, dynamics, and other performance techniques due as assigned. These may be from the method books, concert music, or handouts.
- Each student will understand and be able to explain concert pitch and clef identification as it applies to their instrument.
- Each student will learn to properly care for their instrument, music, folder, handouts, and both the rehearsal and performance spaces.
- Each student will learn a healthy practicing habit to be adopted inside as well as outside of the classroom.
- Each student will learn the basic Italian musical terms, proper pronunciations and their definitions.
- Each student MUST bring their instrument and materials to class each day.
- Each student MUST attend all rehearsals, sectionals, and performances. They will be required to stay through the entirety of each unless previously discussed with the director.
- Each student MUST be respectful and attentive to the director. This attitude will be expected to extend to fellow classmates as well.
- Each student MUST sufficiently prepare assigned music. It is recommended that each student practice at least fifteen minutes a day in order to prepare to the best extent for each performance.
- Each student MUST wear the appropriate attire assigned for each event. See the Extra Costs / Concert Attire section for proper attire guidelines.
- Because this is a yearlong course and the group works as a team, students are not permitted to leave the group after the first two weeks of school. Leaving the group could affect future participation in the performing arts programs at Rancho Christian.


## Tests:

In order to hold students accountable to practicing their music, there will be tests scheduled at the discretion of the director to assess their knowledge and performance capability of assigned music. Tests will be scheduled at least a week in advance to ensure the students have ample time to prepare. Tests will be based on the assignments from the assigned method book (provided by the director), music notation and composition, student's knowledge of the assigned concert pieces, ability to play from memory, posture, proper technique, and ability to vocalize the assigned music.

## Attendance Policy

The week before a concert, daily participation points will be worth double the normal amount. Students MUST be present at EVERY rehearsal the week before a concert. All students must be present at every concert and must stay through the entirety of the concert. No exceptions will be made. In addition to this, students may be called individually or in groups for sectionals outside of the normal class time schedule. These extra rehearsals are on an "as needed" basis and will be scheduled as far in advance as possible. Students unable to attend these extra rehearsals must discuss their absence with Mr. Lybeck at least one day prior to the allotted rehearsal time. A student's absence from sectionals and extra practices could affect their grade if frequently missed.

## Fees

While we wish that being a part of a performing arts group could be completely 'free', the simple fact is that it costs money to run a quality program. The Band \& Choir Fees help cover the costs of the programs from year to year including: new instruments, band owned instrument repairs, band \& choir camps, clinics, supplies, festival expenses (entries and travel), parties, end of the year concert, t-shirts, folders, and large items such as equipment trucks and large band instruments (tubas, percussion, etc). Band \& Choir Fee Payments and fundraising provide the monies to support the Rancho Music Program. All students are responsible for paying for any personal items that they lose or which they will keep (performance polos, shoes, pants, instrument hygiene items, tuners, metronome, etc.). The fees for being in Concert or Symphonic Band is currently $\mathbf{\$ 1 5 0}$ /year payable in one lump sum or installments. Visit this link for more info on fees and payment options.

All students are responsible for paying for any personal or school-owned items that they lose. Students will also be required to purchase the following items no later than the first week of September.

## Attire Requirements:

- Performance Polo (ordered by the director)
- Khaki Pants
- Plain black or white shoes (if in doubt, send me a picture)


## Other Required Purchases:

- Instrument: purchase or rental from local music store (info on website)
- \#2 Pencil (mechanical preferred)
- Personal instrument tuner (may not be shared)
- Notebook with blank music staves (search Amazon for "Standard Wirebound Manuscript Paper" by Hal Leonard)
- Instrument care items: Reeds, cleaning rags, slide oil/valve oil (more complete list will be based on each individual instrument can be found on our website)
